

Bambino and Tball Divisions (Ages 3 to 4 & 5 to 6)

- The only purpose and focus on this age group is safety and fun. Baseball fundamentals at this age are secondary.
- Below are guidelines for your play this season. Managers are expected to communicate and agree upon the specifics of how their games shall be played. If there is a dispute or disagreement, you must stick directly to these rules. Please contact your director for any clarification.
- Please organize and plan all functions (practice and games) to revolve around safety. Set rules for bats, helmets, etc.
- Anyone who has not registered, background checked and Safe Sports Act courses completed through the league are NOT allowed on the field or in the dugouts.
- Games and practices are slotted as 45 and 60 mins respectively. These are not suggestions.
- Both Bambino and Tball shall use the padded baseballs all season. No real, hard baseballs allowed.
- Players must all wear helmets at all times when they are out of the dugout and their team is at-bat.
- Players must be properly equipped at all times. Cups must be worn. Players must wear helmets with FULL FACE GUARD at all times while out of the dugout while their team is batting.
- All teams shall bat the entire lineup EVERY inning. No score or outs are to be recorded in any Bambino game. As the season progresses, Tball managers are encouraged to vary the outs and runs rule if and when BOTH managers of a game agree. It is suggested that the outs be counted but entire lineup still hit for a period of time, then ease into the 3 outs inning over rule.
- Bambino games are to use the tee only, never any coach pitching allowed.
- Tball games are to begin each at-bat with 3 coach pitches, followed by the tee if the batter does not successfully put the ball in play. Tball coaches are to use their own discretion, and at times may exclude the coach pitching to players who are afraid or unwilling.
- Home team supplies baseball for every game, and preps the field for games. Prepping the field includes chalking the batters box and baselines.
- Away team is responsible for cleaning up the field after the games. Raking around the bases and home plate is a must. Clearing out all trash from the dugouts is required. Make sure the lights are off before you leave please.
