

Babe Ruth Divisions
(Ages 13 to 15, 60' pitching distance & 90' base distance)

- Unless stated below, all normal Babe Ruth Baseball rules apply.
- No new inning shall start after 120 minutes or 7 innings.
- Teams are NOT required to bat the entire line-up. If they do bat the lineup, they can make free defensive substitutions. Tournament EH rules and substitution rules are allowed.
- Infield fly rule is enforced.
- Open bases apply, full lead offs and stealing allowed.
- Dropped 3rd strike rule enforced.
- Balk rule is enforced.
- Anyone who has not registered, background checked and Safe Sports Act courses completed through the league are NOT allowed on the field or in the dugouts.
- 7 run max per half inning.
- Bats: May use any bat marked with the USA baseball or BBCOR .50 stamp.
- No jewelry allowed, metal cleats are allowed.
- Players must be properly equipped at all times. Cups must be worn. Players must wear helmets with ear flaps at all times while out of the dugout while their team is batting.
- Mercy rule is 15 after 3, 10 after 4 or when a team is mathematically eliminated.
- During regular season, all games can end in a tie.
- Last recorded out or unused sub can be substituted to run for the catcher with 2 outs in an inning.
- Intentional walks do not require pitches to be thrown, coach instructs umpire.
- Mound conferences limited to baseball rules.
- Any player or coach who warms up a pitcher in the crouched position must wear a helmet or mask.
- Players who throw 45+ pitches in a game cannot catch in the same game. Catchers who catch 3+ innings in a game cannot pitch in the same game.
- Pitchers cannot pitch in multiple games in the same day.
- No player shall appear in a game as a pitcher for 3 consecutive days regardless of pitch counts.
- Home team supplies baseball for every game, and preps the field for games. Prepping the field includes chalking the batters box and baselines.
- Away team is responsible for cleaning up the field after the games. Raking around the bases and home plate is a must. Clearing out all trash from the dugouts is required. Make sure the lights are off before you leave please.

Pitch Count Rules

Pitches	Required Rest
1-30 -	0 Days
31-40 -	1 Day (24 hours)
41-55 -	2 Days (48 hours)
56-70 -	3 Days (72 hours)
71-80 -	4 Days (96 hours)
80 Pitch Maximum per week (5 days)
